

Priority 3:	Fostering Workplaces and Communities that Meet the Needs of Those in or Seeking Recovery
Goal 1:	RRH will provide trainings, professional development opportunities, and technical assistance to the community.
Objective 3.1.A:	Offer Naloxone Administration Training Sessions Throughout the Community.
Action Step	RRH staff will coordinate, plan, and offer Naloxone trainings upon need to public groups and private businesses.
Action Step	Overdose prevention kits and Narcan will be distributed to agencies and businesses throughout community in conjunction with the trainings.
Action Step	Administer pre/post surveys to naloxone training attendees for data collection and improving future sessions.
Action Step	Analysis of pre/post tests to assess program outcomes.
Action Step	Address steps on how to reduce stigma language related to substance use disorders during each naloxone training
Action Step	Provide a certificate of completion for each attendee that participates in the full training, which counts toward PCB CEUs.
Objective 3.1.B:	Increase Professional Development Opportunities for those in Recovery.
Action Step	Plan and host grant writing workshop for local agencies.
Action Step	Solicit training requests via email or website contact to provide education on substance use disorder-related topics.
Action Step	Collaborate with local agencies (e.g., Young Erie Professionals, Erie Chamber of Commerce, etc.) to enhance professional development skills for people in or seeking recovery.
Action Step	Create a bank of established community trainings and funding resources, accessible on the RRH website and updated at least twice a year.
Action Step	Identify 3 topics to create trainings (e.g., recovery capital, overlap of SUDs and trauma, grief, etc.) to offer to the community.
Objective 3.1.C:	Promote Recovery Friendly Workplaces.
Action Step	As referenced in Objective 1A, offer naloxone training upon request to public groups and county-wide businesses.
Action Step	As referenced in Objective 1A, offer and distribute Narcan and harm reduction materials to public groups and local businesses.
Action Step	Continue to partner with and offer as-needed technical assistance to local agencies (e.g., Office of Vocational Rehabilitation, Erie County Reentry Support and Services Alliance, CareerLink, etc.) to meet needs of people of recovery in the workforce.
Objective 3.1.D:	Ongoing Representation by RRH Staff on Various Community Boards.
Action Step	Attend and participate in SCA Quarterly Prevention Meeting.
Action Step	Attend and participate in Erie County Drug and Alcohol Coalition.
Action Step	Attend and participate in DDAP Statewide Overdose Task Force.
Action Step	Attend and participate in Corry Recovery Coalition.
Action Step	Attend and participate in Erie County Opioid Task Force.
Action Step	Attend and participate in Overdose Fatality Review.

Action Step	Attend and participate in Erie County Problem Gambling Taskforce.
Action Step	Attend and participate in Tobacco Free Adagio Healthcare and Policy Workgroup.
Action Step	Attend and participate in other collaboratives as invited and relevant.
