

Priority 1:	Unifying Recovery Community Efforts-Bringing Our Community Partners Under the RRH Umbrella
Goal 1:	Improving System Collaboration to Increase Services for those in Recovery.
Objective 1.1.A:	<i>Engage CRSs to discuss community needs, partnerships, professional development, etc.</i>
Action Step	Plan and host quarterly CRS Support Meetings, guided by input from CRS.
Action Step	Incorporate conversations on needed trainings and support at each quarterly session.
Action Step	Encourage ongoing networking between agencies and peer supports.
Action Step	Identify potential funding streams and opportunities to support non-funded CRS activities, to be reported on our quarterly reports.
Action Step	Use feedback mechanisms to gather input re: meeting times, meeting topics, ongoing issues, etc.
Action Step	Recruitment of local CRS to spearhead 'train the trainer' program for CRS.
Action Step	Work w/ SCA Administration to enforce the written agreements which require CRS participation in RRH events and activities for a contracted number of hours.
Objective 1.1.B:	<i>Engage community stakeholders to discuss community needs, partnerships, professional development, etc.</i>
Action Step	Plan and host quarterly Treatment Provider meetings.
Action Step	Plan and host quarterly Community Planning Committee meetings.
Action Step	Use feedback mechanisms at each meeting to gather input re: meeting times, meeting topics, ongoing issues, etc.
Action Step	Explore options for monthly/quarterly sharing of information to streamline communication.
Objective 1.1.C:	<i>Enhancing recovery services for people from underrepresented communities.</i>
Action Step	Await for further direction from DDAP on development of equity coalition.
Action Step	Continue RRH outreach to local organizations that serve underrepresented populations including LGBTQ+, veterans, rural, disabled, culturally diverse, and ESL populations.
Action Step	Collaborating w/ Taylor's HOPE on identifying the voices of the underrepresented populations for a local documentary focusing on substance related deaths.
Objective 1.1.D:	<i>Facilitate community discussion on creation and adoption of programs and policies to increase youth services.</i>
Action Step	Host quarterly youth-focused meetings, attended by education, service agencies, and criminal justice entities that work with young people.
Action Step	Continue to represent RRH on youth prevention committees throughout the community.
Action Step	Continue to recruit school-based staff to participate in the RRH Youth efforts.
